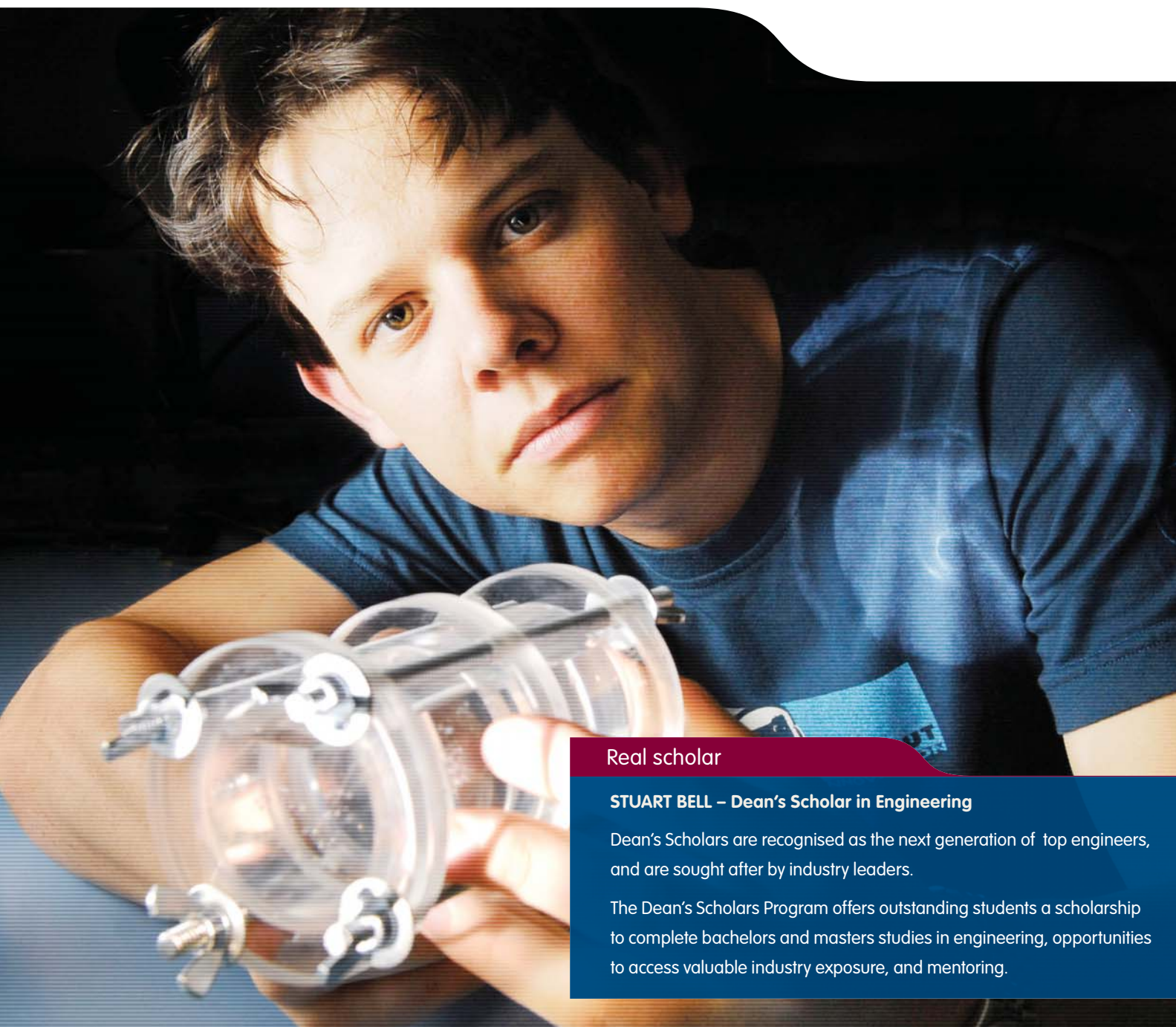

WHAT IS THE DEAN'S SCHOLARS PROGRAM?

The Dean's Scholars Program is the only scholarship and development program of its kind in Queensland, making QUT a university of choice for engineers.

It is designed specifically for future leaders to complete a Bachelor of Engineering while developing skills and contacts through industry exposure, networking and mentoring.

The Dean's Scholars Program is open to Australian and international students with outstanding academic ability and leadership potential, who are entering University from Year 12 or returning from a gap year.

Australian students receive a full scholarship for their entire undergraduate student contribution. International students successful in gaining entry will receive a scholarship for approximately one-third of their tuition fees.

Students who complete their degree with a course grade point average of 6.0 or above and accept an offer to continue to the masters program will continue to receive scholarship benefits.

WHY CHOOSE THE DEAN'S SCHOLARS PROGRAM?

If you are accepted into the Dean's Scholars Program, your scholarship will give you a real head start.

Dean's Scholars are a small, elite group of students with top OP scores, and high levels of school and community leadership. Graduates of the Dean's Scholars Program are recognised as potential future leaders in engineering.

As a Dean's Scholar you will network with current industry leaders in a range of organised forums including:

- company site visits with major industry players, which give you the opportunity to experience engineering environments and high-level engineering management
- an annual leadership dinner
- events relating to industry and associations
- close interaction with senior academics who have strong industry links

Some industry sponsors also offer boardroom visits, which give Dean's Scholars the opportunity to experience engineering environments and high level engineering management.

HOW DO I BECOME A DEAN'S SCHOLAR?

Students who have completed high school within Australia must apply via QTAC for the Bachelor of Engineering (Dean's Scholars Program), course code 412052.

In addition to academic achievement, applicants will be selected for their leadership potential based on responses to a questionnaire, which is available at bee.qut.edu.au/study/scholarships/commencing

Questionnaires must be submitted by the due date, and applicants may be required to attend an interview.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS
